

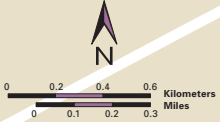

# DIRECTIONS TO RUTGERS–NEW BRUNSWICK

## FROM THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE

Turn off at Exit 9, bear right after the tollbooths and follow signs for “Route 18 North–New Brunswick.” Stay to the left to continue on Route 18 North.

### To COOK AND DOUGLASS CAMPUSES

Proceed on Route 18 North and after passing the intersection of Paulus Boulevard, bear right to access the local lanes and follow the signs for “New Brunswick Exits.” At the first traffic light, make a left onto George Street–Route 172–Cook/Douglass. Continue through the first light and at the roundabout, bear right onto George Street. At the next light, Nichol Avenue, you are in the heart of the Douglass Campus; the Douglass Campus Center is on the left side. For the Cook Campus, turn left at the traffic light onto Nichol Avenue and follow the signs to the Cook Campus.

### To COLLEGE AVENUE CAMPUS

Proceed along Route 18 North and bear right to access the local lanes. Follow the signs to Rutgers University College Avenue Campus, and take the “George Street–Rutgers University–College Avenue Campus” exit (approximately 2.6 miles from the Turnpike). At the top of the exit ramp, bear right on George Street to head toward the Rutgers Student Center and Alexander Library, or bear left on George Street to head toward the Zimmerli Art Museum, Old Queens, and downtown New Brunswick.

### To BUSCH AND LIVINGSTON CAMPUSES

Proceed along Route 18 North and bear left to access the express lanes. Cross the Raritan River (approximately 3.7 miles from the Turnpike). Continue on Route 18 North. For the Busch Campus, take the first exit marked “Campus Road, Busch Campus.” For the Livingston Campus, take the second exit, marked “Metlars Lane, Livingston Campus, Rutgers RAC” and bear right onto Avenue E immediately before the light.

## FROM ROUTE 1

### To COOK AND DOUGLASS CAMPUSES

From Route 1 Southbound, proceed past the turn for Route 18 to College Farm Road. Follow the signs to the George H. Cook Campus. Bear right at the exit and make a right at the yield sign onto College Farm Road and follow signs for the campuses.

From Route 1 Northbound, proceed past DeVry and bear right at the next exit. Follow the signs to Route 1 South. Make a right and proceed under the highway and make a right at the stop light. Proceed past Bristol-Myers Squibb and make a left onto College Farm Road.

### To COLLEGE AVENUE, BUSCH, AND LIVINGSTON CAMPUSES

Turn off at “Route 18 North–New Brunswick” and proceed to the campuses as you would from the New Jersey Turnpike.

## FROM ROUTE 287

### To COOK AND DOUGLASS CAMPUSES

Turn off at Exit 9 “River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park.” Proceed east on River Road toward Highland Park. Make a right onto Route 18 South (after the traffic light at Landing Lane). Cross the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge. Continue on Route 18 South. Follow signs for the New Brunswick exits, and make a right at the Commercial Avenue exit. Proceed to the second light, and make a left onto George Street. You will enter the Douglass Campus in the vicinity of the Douglass Campus Center. For the Cook Campus, make a right at the light onto Nichol Avenue and follow signs.

### To COLLEGE AVENUE CAMPUS

Turn off at Exit 9 “River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park.” Proceed east on River Road toward Highland Park. Make a right onto Route 18 South (after the traffic light at Landing Lane). Cross the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge. Stay in the right lane and take the first exit, marked “George Street–Rutgers University, New Brunswick, Route 27.” At the traffic light at the top of the exit ramp, proceed straight onto George Street to head toward the Zimmerli Art Museum, Old Queens, and downtown New Brunswick, or turn right onto Huntington Street, then turn left at the first traffic light onto College Avenue for the Rutgers Student Center.

### To BUSCH AND LIVINGSTON CAMPUSES

Turn off at Exit 9 “River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park.” Proceed east on River Road toward Highland Park. Continue on River Road and go under the overpass for Route 18. Make a left onto Route 18 North. For the Busch Campus, take the first exit, marked “Campus Road, Busch Campus.” For the Livingston Campus, take the second exit, marked “Metlars Lane, Livingston Campus, Rutgers RAC.” Bear right onto Avenue E immediately before the light.

## FROM THE GARDEN STATE PARKWAY

### SOUTHBOUND (FROM NORTHERN POINTS)

Turn off at Exit 129 for the New Jersey Turnpike and head south. Follow the directions to campus from the New Jersey Turnpike.

### NORTHBOUND (FROM SOUTHERN POINTS)

Turn off at Exit 105 and follow signs for Route 18 North. After approximately 24 miles, you will pass the entrance for the New Jersey Turnpike. Follow the directions to campus from the New Jersey Turnpike.

## NJ TRANSIT

### Rail Service to New Brunswick Train Station

NJ Transit’s Northeast Corridor Line provides rail service to New York Penn Station, Secaucus Transfer, Newark Penn Station, Newark Liberty International Airport, North Elizabeth, Elizabeth, Linden, Rahway, Metropark (Iselin), Metuchen, Edison, New Brunswick, Jersey Avenue (New Brunswick), Princeton Junction, Hamilton, and Trenton.

NJ Transit’s Northeast Corridor Line connects with PATH service to New York at Newark Penn Station, to Riverline Service to Camden at the Trenton Station, and with SEPTA service to Philadelphia at the Trenton Station.

### SHUTTLE SERVICES

The **Knight Mover** is an individualized, demand-responsive service from all campus locations in New Brunswick and Piscataway that runs Sunday through Wednesday, 3 a.m.–6:45 p.m.

Students in need of transportation *on or between* any New Brunswick campus after the Library Shuttle and Inter-Campus Bus System cease to operate can call 732-932-RIDE (7433) from a campus emergency phone or the Rutgers University Police Department at 732-932-7211 to request transportation to their destination.

The **New BrunsQuick Shuttle** serves the New Brunswick and Rutgers communities during peak commuter hours (6 a.m.–9 a.m. and 4 p.m.–7 p.m.) with a loop service that stops at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, St. Peter's Medical Center, the fifth and sixth wards in New Brunswick, the College of Nursing, and the College Avenue Campus. From 9 a.m. until 4 p.m., and again from 7 p.m. until 2 a.m., the shuttle loops around the College Avenue Campus and the fifth and sixth wards in New Brunswick.

## Division of Administration and Public Safety

Administration and Public Safety (APS) is committed to improving the quality of safety and support services on campus. The operational units of APS include the Department of Emergency Services, Construction Code Enforcement, Environmental Health and Safety, DOTS, the Office of Emergency Management, and the internationally accredited Rutgers University Police Department. Public safety personnel are responsible for responding to all emergencies (police, fire, emergency medical, hazardous material, and environmental challenges). DOTS works closely with the operational units and provides transportation to more students, faculty, staff, and visitors than any university system in the country.

APS, through the Business and Administrative Services Department, oversees the operations of Rutgers' own 4½ star 18-hole golf course, the Barnes & Noble Bookstores at Rutgers, postal services, records retention, and security technologies.
